Dear Sir/Madam,

As an importer of goods into the European Union, we are required to comply with the EU Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM), established by Regulation (EU) 2023/956. Under this regulation, we must report the greenhouse gas emissions embedded in the goods we import from your installation.

We kindly request that you provide us with the following information for the reporting period [YEAR]:

1. Direct emissions from your installation (in tonnes of CO₂ equivalent) attributable to the production of the goods we purchase.
2. Indirect emissions from electricity consumed during production (if applicable).
3. Total production volume of the relevant goods during the reporting period.
4. Description of the production process and system boundaries used.
5. Whether the goods are "simple goods" or "complex goods" within the meaning of Annex IV of the Regulation.
6. If complex goods: the specific embedded emissions of each precursor material.
7. Any carbon price paid in your country for these emissions (tax, ETS allowances, or levy), including any rebates.

Alternatively, you may register your installation in the CBAM Registry of the European Commission (Article 10) and share verified emissions data directly through the portal. Our EORI number is: DE801234567000015.

Please note that if we are unable to obtain actual emissions data, we will be required to use default emission values published by the European Commission, which typically result in higher CBAM costs.

We appreciate your cooperation and are available to discuss this further.
